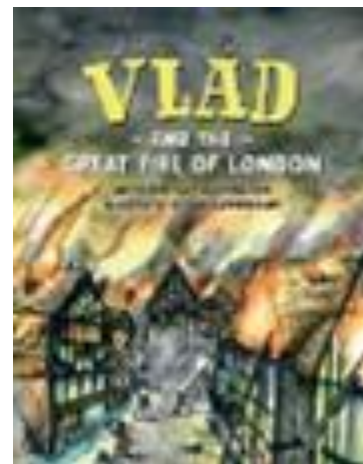
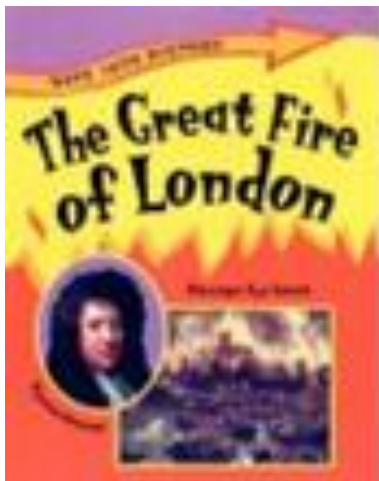
Welcome to the Autumn 2 Term Year Two newsletter.
